HALF TERM 2:

STUDENTS MUST KNOW:

Theme: 'Called and chosen'

<u>Keywords:</u> Old Testament, New Testament, Original Sin, Prophet, Covenant, Decalogue.

Topics that will be covered:

- Old testament teachings- The fall, Cain and Abel.
- Exploring covenants- Noah, Moses.
- Linking religious teachings and laws in society- The 10 commandments.

Knowledge tests in lesson, extended writing tasks, skills-based questions

HALF TERM 3:

STUDENTS MUST KNOW:

<u>Theme:</u> 'Galilee to Jerusalem'

<u>Keywords:</u> Miracle, parable, Samaritan, Prodigal, Paschal Mystery.

<u>Topics that will be covered:</u>

- New testament teachings- the birth of Jesus, the baptism of Jesus.
- Jesus' miracles- Healing of the Blind man. Feeding of the 5,000
- Jesus' parables- Good Samaritan. Prodigal son.
- The last days in Jesus' life- Paschal mystery.

HALF TERM 4:

Theme: 'Desert to Garden'

<u>Keywords:</u> Lent, Maundy Thursday, Sacrifice, Easter,

- The importance of the Last Supper
- The Crucifixion
- The Resurrection

HALF TERM 5:

STUDENTS MUST KNOW:

Theme: 'To the ends of the Earth'

<u>Keywords:</u> Sacraments, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Confirmation, Holy Orders, Anointing of the Sick.

Topics that will be covered:

- The importance of the sacraments.
- Identify different sacraments.
- Explore how different religions celebrate key mile stones in life.
