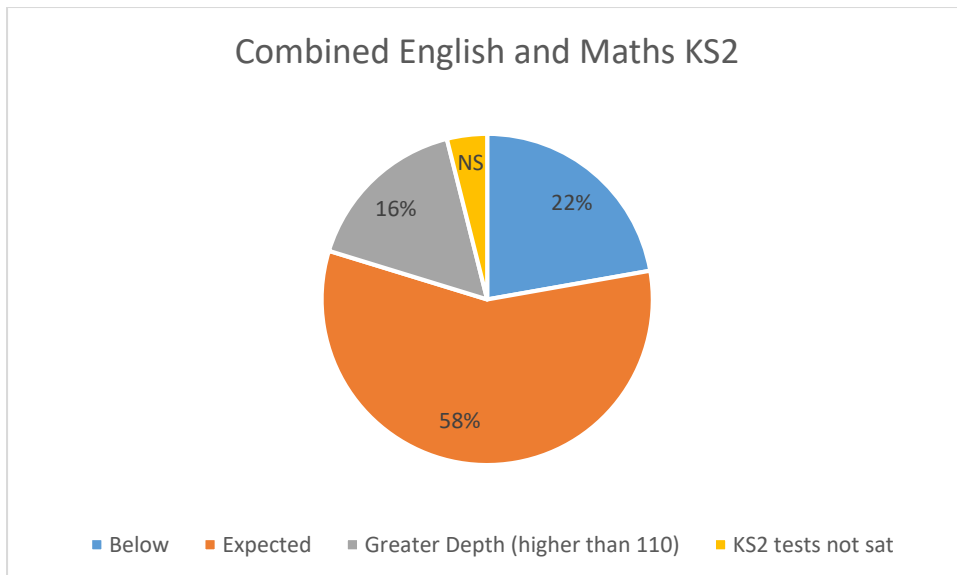


Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Uplift Premium 2019-2020 Amount of money allocated to Stuart Bathurst Catholic High School - £13 910

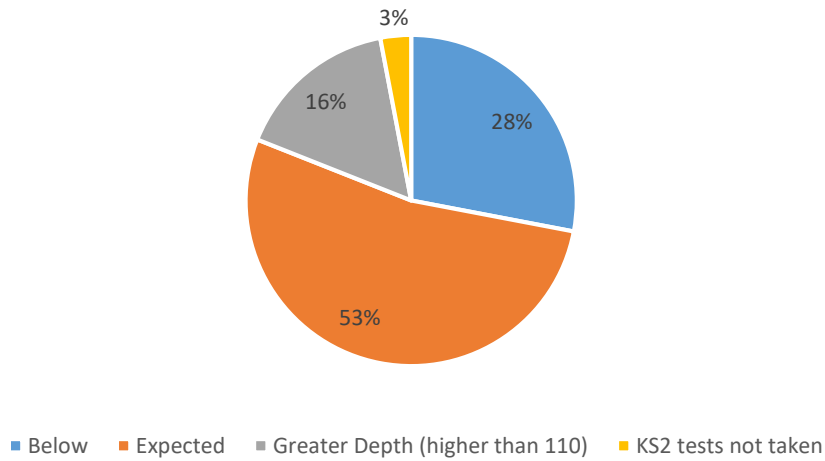
How has this money been spent?

- Cognitive Abilities Tests (CATS) - these are used to accurately predict target grades for students and identify strengths and weaknesses in the cohort.



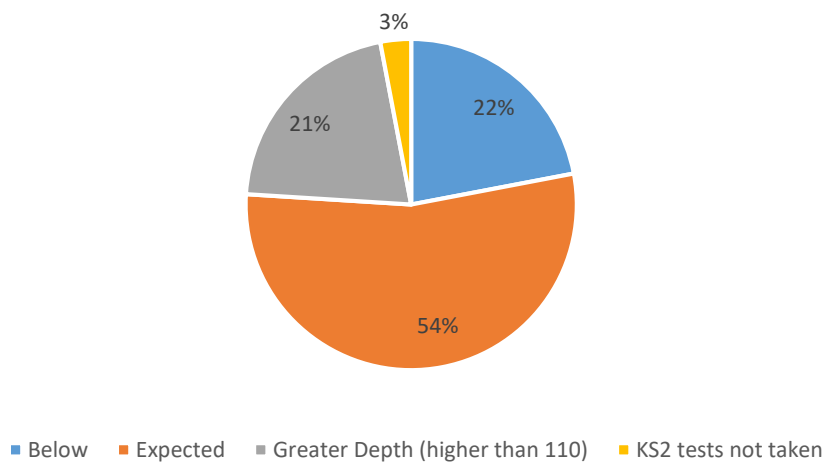
Of the 153 pupils who joined Stuart Bathurst Catholic High School in year 7 in 2019, 22% of pupils were working below the expected standard according to their combined KS2 Maths and English scores. 58% were at expected standard and 16% were working at greater depth.

Of the pupils who joined Stuart Bathurst Catholic High School in year 7 in 2019, 28% were of pupils were working below the expected standard in Combined English Scores.
