It is expected that all Sixth Formers wear their correct Sixth Form attire everyday within the school environment.

This a reminder of the Sixth Form uniform policy, of which is non-negotiable:

There will be **zero tolerance** to the following:

-  Trainers/Boots/Canvas Shoes
-  Hoodies/Branded Sport Jumpers/T-Shirts
-  Unnatural hair colouring/styles
-  Extensive, multiple piercings (No to Tongue, nose, multiple earrings etc)
-  Excessive Make Up/Jewellery
-  Not bringing/wearing blazer/tie with Sixth Form Pin Badge
-  Demin/leather/lycra materials
-  Shorts/leggings/skinny fit trousers/Skirts above the knee

The head of Sixth Form and the school leadership team reserve the right to send a student home if they feel that the uniform policy is not met. A smart, business-like presentation must be always maintained. Suit jackets may be taken off when in the Sixth Form centre and in class with the permission of the teacher.
